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Mother and Daughter Heritage

Our center has two legacies of love through their family serving our families. Both Nikki Gifford and Kathy Combs have been serving AC's clients for 12 years together. Below is their story of love within family ties.

Nikki Gifford is the Administrative Director of Advocacy Center and has been since May of 2022. She is a single mom of an 8-year-old little boy name M.J. Gifford. Nikki has always wanted to be a mom since she was a little girl. After having worked with kids all her life, starting at a young age babysitting to working in the nursery at a local private school and her church, she loves children. Three years ago, she found out she had a rare brain tumor. Once the tumor was discovered, Nikki's family had many doctor's appointments with little to no hope. In 2020, they

found a surgeon to operate. Nikki went to Charleston to undergo a complicated and very risky surgery. Since 2020 she has been in recovery from the cancerous tumor that threatened her life. Nikki is Kathy and Royce Combs' firstborn daughter. Kathy has



been involved with our center since 2015. First, Royce served on the Board of Directors. Then, through his position Kathy saw how the center helped single moms in tough times. She moved to Sumter in 1984 with her family, as her father had re-



tired from Shaw Air Force Base. She and Royce married after she graduated from Hillcrest High in 1988. Royce was in the Air Force so they left on assignment, then returned to Sumter in 2006 and have been in Sumter for 16 years now. Kathy is Assistant Nursery Coordinator at her church so Nikki's servant heart and love for family comes through a long line. Kathy says her Grandparents and Great Grandparents offered prayers regularly, even daily. Kathy became a Christian at six years old. Though it was years ago, she continues to strive to live her life through the bible's instruction. Beginning at our center, she volunteered, progressed to staff as front desk, then Codirector in 2021, and then Vice President of the B.O.Ds in 2022. Their family line has seen many sacrifices. Through their story, reflections of God and his desire for families are woven. They are a family of service. The quote from Ephesians in the margin depicts marriage and it is through this that Christ's love is reflected in the church. Kathy and Royce's marriage and their daughter Nikki depict this familial love. Thank you Nikki, Royce, and Kathy for your service to our center and the legacy you leave here.




